




CARGO CONDITION SURVEYS

The cargo condition surveys are the first step of the shipment on loading or discharging operations and designed to protect Owners / Charterers from cargo claims which may have occured prior to operation on board the vessel as well as the damages during the loading and discharging regarding the cargo condition.







VESSEL CONDITION SURVEYS

The main purpose of this inspection is to ensure the seaworthiness of the vessel, its hull and its components (decks, liners, partitions, crimps, etc.) retain their integrity and strength sufficient to successfully confront the forces encountered by the vessel at sea, and, secondly, that the tightness of the ease and closures of all kinds of slots (hatches, entrances, fans, pipelines, scuppers, etc.) is insured, i.e the buoyancy of the vessel is provided. This check allows you to ensure that the state of seaworthiness will ensure safety at sea away from the ship, people and the environment.









This will include:

Determination of the extent of damage to the cargo during loading and discharging, etc.;

Witnessing storage, loading and discharging, which caused to damage to the cargo;


Calculation of the shortage;


Description and recommendations to address the causes of damage or loss of cargo;

Assistance in the investigation of insurance claims and resolution claimant's losses.




